

YOUTH ACCESS FUND

Outward Bound Canada's Youth Access Fund helps to remove financial barriers so that more youth can access the life-changing benefits of Outward Bound. We strive to provide programs across the country that offer a supportive and inclusive environment from diverse social, cultural and economic backgrounds, and for those facing a variety of barriers to getting outdoors. Our mission is to cultivate resilience, leadership, connections and compassion through inspiring and challenging journeys of discovery in the natural world. Our vision is for a healthy, resilient society formed through lasting connections to self, others and the natural world.

The Youth Access Fund is aimed to reduce financial barriers to accessing Outward Bound Canada programs, and is based on financial need: a "pay what you can" approach. The program will subsidize a significant amount of the course fee. Funds awarded are applied directly toward the costs of course fees. Applicants who have never received funding support through Outward Bound Canada are considered in priority to ensure that as many youth as possible can benefit from the programs. We encourage eligible applicants to apply early to get the best chance at receiving financial assistance!

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant must be between 12–19 years of age and currently residing in Canada.
- Applicant must demonstrate financial need and fall within the income eligibility criteria.
- Applicant must understand the expectations of the program and provide informed consent.
- Applicant must be interested and motivated to participate.



How to Apply

- 1. Apply online during the registration process when you sign up for your course and complete all required forms. Alternatively, you can complete the attached package by sending it back to us by email or fax. If you need further assistance to complete the application, please email or call us to discuss other options. Pay \$100 deposit payment at the time of application.
- 2. You may be requested to provide additional information or documentation, and both the applicant and parent/guardian will be asked to participate in a phone call to learn more about the program.
- 3. You will receive a confirmation by email with the amount of funding awarded. You will be requested to sign a Funding Agreement to confirm your commitment. If your application is not approved, you will have the option to stay in the course and pay the full balance, switch courses, or receive a full refund of your deposit payment.
